



Milk Order Form

Trinity School of Texas Semester Milk Program

- ✓ Semester Milk Plan includes 8 oz. low fat white milk, 8 oz. low fat chocolate milk, 4 oz. orange juice, or 4 oz. apple juice. Milk (and juice) will be available by semester.
- ✓ If you choose to purchase the semester milk plan, your child has a drink every school day during that semester, whether you order a hot lunch or not. Therefore, it is not necessary to send drinks with your child on the days you send a sack lunch - your child may come through the line to get milk. If you choose not to order the semester milk plan, your child will not be able to get milk on the days a hot lunch is ordered or a sack lunch is sent.
- ✓ Water is always available for students and glasses are provided.
- ✓ There have been questions as to why children can't get milk on an as needed basis. TST Food Service is required to order milk for an entire semester. We are not able to order day by day or week by week. Thank you for your understanding in this matter!

If you ordered milk for the fall semester, **YOU WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE RENEWED FOR THE SPRING SEMESTER UNLESS YOU NOTIFY THE FOOD SERVICE DIRECTOR OTHERWISE.**

Milk/juice cannot be ordered or distributed until the semester fee is paid.
