

Trinity School of Texas Extended Enrichment Frequently Asked Questions 2022 - 2023

Q. What ages are served by Extended Enrichment?

A. Ages two through fifth grade may enroll in Extended Enrichment.

Q. What is the daily schedule for Early Childhood students enrolled in Extended Enrichment?

A. Two and three year old students go to Extended Enrichment at 11:30am. They will eat lunch, potty or diaper change and nap until approximately 2:30pm. Some students will leave at the 3:00 pm carpool and others will be offered a snack, participate in an educational or art activity and enjoy time on the playground. All students should be picked up by 6:00 pm.

Q. What is the daily schedule for Pre-K and Lower School students in Extended Enrichment?

A. Pre-K and LS students go to Extended Enrichment at 3:00pm. They will be offered a snack and participate in activities and games in the classroom. Students who have homework will have time to work on assignments. All students will enjoy time on the playground.

Q. Will my child have the same teacher in Extended Enrichment as in the morning?

A. Occasionally an Extended Enrichment class will have the same teacher as in the morning, but typically, a different teacher will teach the afternoon class.

Q. What will my child need to bring to school for Extended Enrichment?

A. Two and three year old students will need to bring a nap mat, blanket and "lovie," if needed. All students should have their own water bottles.

Q. Will students have the opportunity to work on homework during Extended Enrichment?

A. Yes, students who have homework will have time designated for completing assignments. Teachers are available for assistance.

Q. What happens if I want to pick up my EC child in Extended Enrichment at 3:00pm carpool?

A. Let the Extended Enrichment teacher know and your child will be sent to the Pre-K carpool pick-up at the second awning of the Martin Building at 3:00pm.

Q. What happens if my child is signed up for Tumble Time and/or drama?

A. Your child will be sent to any extra-curricular classes after school and returned to Extended Enrichment by the teacher.

Q. What if my child needs medication?

A. Complete the parent's authorization for medication (found on myTST or in the Main Office) and submit it with the medication in a labeled ziplock bag. The medication must be in the original prescription container with the identity and usage label. An approved faculty/staff member will administer the medication to your child.

Q. What happens if I need someone else to pick up my child?

A. If someone other than the parent or those listed as emergency contacts, they will need to show their ID upon pick-up. Prior to pick-up parents should contact the Extended Enrichment office to let them know who will be picking up their child.

Q. Will Extended Enrichment be open on Teacher In-Service, Conference Days or holidays?

A. At this time, no. On these specific occasions faculty and staff are in meetings and professional development.

Q. Do I have to register my child every year, or will he/she be registered automatically?

A. You will be sent a form through myTST to register your child for Extended Enrichment. It will be sent at the end of the prior school year or when a child is enrolled in school.
