

ACADEMIC DEVELOPMENT:

Students will find a fun and challenging curriculum that includes phonics, grammar, Writer's Workshop, mathematics, social studies, and science. Every subject is taught with a hands-on, active learning approach, which includes projects, small-group collaboration, experiments, and more.

At TST, it is our deepest desire to exemplify God's love in everything we do. Lower school students engage in daily devotionals, chapel, and community service and have Chapel buddies that help their spiritual growth. As a school accepting of all faiths, we partner with parents to empower students with the guidance and confidence they need to explore their faith and lead meaningful lives.

ENRICHED LEARNING:

Art, music, PE, library, computers, Spanish, and other specials expand our students' learning beyond core subjects. TST prioritizes enriching every student's learning experience — with opportunities such as drama production, STEAM, character development, and developing their God-given skills by participating in various academic competitions at Private Schools Interscholastic Association (PSIA). Middle school is when our students really start to come into their own. They're busy discovering new passions and talents while also starting to better understand who they are and what they stand for. We prepare them for what's ahead by challenging them with a more rigorous curriculum and by encouraging them to be more involved within the community.

At Trinity School of Texas, we introduce middle schoolers to what's possible and instill in them the confidence and spiritual foundation they need to achieve it:

- Master subjects and explore courses that interest them personally and professionally, through a well-rounded curriculum encompassing academics, athletics, community service, and character building
- Deepen their faith and build up their values through religion courses, worship and service
- Develop healthy relationships with peers and mentors through involvement in clubs, student organizations, and team sports
- Expand their passions and interests through distinct electives and extracurriculars such as art, robotics, eSports, drama, choir, Spanish, educational travel, and PSIA academic competitions
- Strengthen important life skills needed for future success, including study skills, creative problem solving, responsibility, accountability and independence
