Vaccine Policy - Trinity School of Texas

Prior to school attendance, it is crucial that each student presents or has on file with the school a current up-to-date immunization record. These records indicate vaccinations for the prevention of those communicable diseases for which the Department of Health requires immunization. By ensuring these records are up-to-date, parents are taking a proactive step in safeguarding their child's health and the health of the school community.

At Trinity, we recognize and respect two principal types of exemptions from school vaccination requirements: medical and reasons of conscience (including religious reasons). We understand and respect the sincere convictions and personal beliefs of individuals about vaccines. However, we also acknowledge the overwhelming benefits of vaccinations to individuals and the community at large. They contribute significantly to crucial herd immunity for those who cannot be vaccinated due to medical reasons. For this reason, Trinity prioritizes admissions based on vaccination rates in each class/division, with a priority of maintaining 95% vaccine rates schoolwide.
